Dear Linda,

I am emailing you to confirm that your upcoming reservation from 7/11/18 to 7/12/18 at Alpine Shadows Condo #3 is officially booked & secure, and I wanted to THANK YOU again for booking our 3-bedroom/2-bathroom property in the Heart of Old Town Park City for your overnight getaway!

Our condo building Alpine Shadows is located at 1035 Park Avenue, between 10th and 11th Streets, and it is a Gray building with Yellow accents. Check-In time is any time after 4:00 PM and Check-Out time is promptly at 10:00 AM, and your door codes will be electronically enabled and disabled at these times. Early Check-In and Late Check-Out times can be arranged in advance for an additional fee based on availability, but you must notify me in advance to arrange access. Last minute requests cannot always be accommodated and may incur additional charges.

If you are bringing a car, when you access through the garage please pause for a moment for the sensor to open automatically. If it does not open by the sensor, you will need to open the garage door by walking through the door to the right of the garage door, which leads you to the stairwell, which will then lead you to the inside garage door. On your left, there are a series of garage door buttons. Hit the "OPEN" button and park in one of the spots marked for "3". Please note that if two cars are coming through the garage back-to-back, you must hit the "STOP" button to hold the garage door open, otherwise the garage door will come down automatically after the first car has come through. Please also beware of the LOW height of the garage, which may be problematic if driving a large SUV or truck. If you are unable to fit in the garage, there is Free Parking outside in the back of the building on Woodside Drive marked for "Alpine Shadows" but you will need to hang the blue Parking Permit Hangtag from your rear view mirror located inside the condo. Once in the garage you will see a Storage Unit Door "3", which is our Private Space to store equipment, luggage and gear with the same door code.

To access the condo, go back up the stairwell you first entered up one flight to Condo #3. Your Unique Personal Door Code for your stay is 0711, which is also your check-in date for easy remembering, and this code will open both the Condo & Storage Doors. The code will be enabled electronically at 4:00 PM on the day of your arrvial and disabled at 10:00 AM on your departure day, and all doors will lock automatically when the doors close. Early Check-In and Late Check-Out times can be arranged in advance for an additional fee, so please let me know if you'd like to add one or both options prior to your arrival. The Early Check-In Fee is \$100 and will allow you to have access to the condo, parking & amenities at 10:00 am. The Late Check-Out Fee is \$100 and will allow you to stay in the condo and have parking privileges until 4:00 PM. The fee to add both options is \$150.

Once you are inside of the condo, you will find 2 Automatic Garage Door Openers and the Orange Parking Permit in the Top Left Drawer in the kitchen. Please feel free to use them during your stay, and note that they ONLY OPEN the garage doors as the doors will shut automatically on a time sensor. Also please remember to RETURN both the garage door openers and the parking permit to the kitchen drawer prior to checking out. If they are not returned prior to check-out, the \$200 will be withheld from your security damage deposit, as that is unfortunately the price our condo association charges to replace them. There is a Black Binder on the kitchen counter with Condo Instructions, Guest Guide, Restaurant Recommendations, and many other useful resources, so please take time to peruse its contents upon your arrival.

We kindly ask that you take off your shoes once inside the condo, and please use the boot trays provided to store your shoes. We have just recently renovated the floors, carpets, bathrooms and furniture this fall, and want to avoid any damage to them due to the abrasive & damaging salt from outdoors. Please also remember to turn off all the lights, fans, tv and radios before you leave the condo to conserve energy.

Unfortunately the outdoor hot tub in our condo complex is currently closed for the season until the fall.
